The following is an aspirational statement for REALTOR® and Affiliate Members of GRAR who desire to promote diversity, equity, and inclusion and to advocate for fair housing in our community.

I agree to:

- Provide equal professional service without regard to the race, color, religion, disability, familial status, marital status, age, national origin, or sex, including sexual orientation or gender identity, of any prospective client, customer, or of the residents of any community.
- Keep informed about fair housing laws and practices to improve my clients' and customers' opportunities to see, buy, or lease property.
- Ensure that my advertising indicates that everyone is welcome, and no one is excluded.
- Inform my clients and customers about their rights and responsibilities under the fair housing laws.
- Encourage others to honor and comply with all fair housing laws.
